

Development Coordinator Year-End Report

This season provided a strong focus on player development across all age groups, with a variety of well-attended and successful programs delivered throughout the year.

Preseason development sessions were held from September through October for U8–U14 players, as well as goalies. These sessions emphasized foundational skills, conditioning, and preparing athletes for the upcoming season. Participation and engagement were excellent, setting a positive tone for the year.

On November 29th, a dedicated goalie camp was held, which proved to be a major success. The camp featured a number of high-performance coaches and experienced players, providing goalies with elite-level instruction. Feedback from participants and families was overwhelmingly positive, and the event was noted for its organization and quality.

In December, both beginner and advanced shooting clinics were offered. Interest in these sessions was extremely high, with both reaching maximum capacity. These clinics focused on shooting technique, accuracy, and speed and were well received by all participants.

Over the Christmas break, development camps for U10 and U12 players were held. These camps were successful in maintaining player engagement during the holiday period while continuing to build on skills introduced earlier in the season.

Finally, the season concluded for registered players with a March Break camp for U8–U12 players and goalies. This final development opportunity provided a fun and productive environment for athletes to continue improving their skills and confidence on the ice.

For the second year, the association held Intro to Ringette, which is a four week program that introduces players ages 4-9 to the Sport of Ringette, this wrapped up on April 5th with over a dozen participants. The association will reach out to all participants to request feedback, and provide registration information for the 2026/2027 season.

Overall, the year was highly successful, with strong participation, positive feedback, and meaningful development opportunities provided across all age groups.
